

City of Hayward Ordinance Establishing Fees and Charges

ORDINANCE NO. 004-2018

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR VARIOUS SERVICES, LICENSES AND PERMITS FOR THE CITY OF HAYWARD, MN.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Hayward, MN has adopted the Minnesota Basic Code of Ordinances as it has been amended and supplemented to be its city code and that code permits the city to adopt by ordinance a schedule of fees and charges for various services, licenses and permits.

All fees and charges in effect as of the date of the adoption of the city code for the city shall remain in effect unless otherwise modified by the provision of this ordinance.

Now Therefore, the City Council of the City of Hayward, Minnesota, ordains:

1. Community hall rental rates shall be \$50 per calendar day for residents of the City and Township of Hayward, MN, and \$100 per calendar day for all others;
2. Non-sufficient funds/returned checks shall be charged \$30 per instance;
3. Utility late fees shall be assessed at \$25 per quarter, pro-rated for residents that have entered into alternative payment arrangements with the City Clerk/Treasurer;
4. Annual liquor licenses, including Sunday sales, shall cost \$2,500 annually, pro-rated as appropriate for partial years;
5. Residential and commercial water and sewer hook-up fees shall be \$300; and
6. Residential and commercial reconnection fee of \$75 per instance;
7. City construction authorization form, open burning recreational fire pits, use of park shelter and/or softball fee shall have no fee;
8. Mayor's compensation per council meeting shall be \$70;
9. Council member compensation per council meeting shall be \$60;
10. Temporary commercial water usage - \$15 per 1,000 gallons with a \$50 minimum;
11. Request for ordinance variance shall require a \$25 payment to be paid at the time of application;
12. City mowing of private/commercial property to abate grass/weed nuisance ordinance violations – the City shall charge \$100 per hour with a one hour minimum.
