

POSTED NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES  
TO VOTERS OF HAYWARD CITY IN  
FREEBORN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The following precincts located in Freeborn County have elected to vote by mail ballot procedures in state wide elections as authorized under Minnesota Statutes 204B.45. All other precincts vote at their designated polling places on Election Day.

**HAYWARD CITY**

**For 2018 state wide elections, the election dates and the corresponding dates that ballots will be mailed to all registered voters in mail ballot precincts are:**

**State wide Primary Election: August 14, 2018**

**Ballot Mailing Dates: June 29 - July 31, 2018**

**State wide General Election: November 6, 2018**

**Ballot Mailing Dates: September 21 - October 23, 2018**

**Each voter registered by July 24, 2018 for the State wide Primary Election, and/or October 16, 2018 for the State wide General Election will be mailed a ballot automatically.**

Eligible voters not pre-registered by the dates noted, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Freeborn County Auditor-Treasurer's Office by phone 507-377-5121, mail or in person for an absentee ballot application.

All ballots may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), or may be delivered in person, or delivered by designated agent to:

Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

In addition to the normal business hours, extended hours for mail ballot voting are:

State wide Primary Election: Saturday, August 11, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.;  
Monday, August 13, 2018 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

State wide General Election: Saturday, November 3, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.;  
Monday November 5, 2018 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.;

**The polling place for this election will be at Auditor-Treasurer's Office, Freeborn County Government Center.**

The polls will be open:

State wide Primary Election: Tuesday, August 14, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

State wide General Election: Tuesday, November 6, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

At least one AutoMark ballot-marker will be available at that polling place that permit persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently and that permit any voter to submit their ballot to be automatically checked and corrected for voting errors prior to being cast and counted.

All mail ballots will be counted at the Auditor-Treasurer's Office after 8:00 p.m. on the respective election dates.
