**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND CERTIFYING THE 2019 PRELIMINARY  
TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF HAYWARD WITH HAYWARD TOWNSHIP**


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WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute § 275.065 subd 1a states, "Notwithstanding any law or charter to the contrary, on or before September 30, each taxing authority, other than a school district, shall adopt a proposed budget and shall certify to the county auditor the proposed or, in the case of a town, the final property tax levy for taxes payable in the following year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Hayward, that it proposes the following tax levy which, if adopted pursuant to Minnesota Law, will be ordered on all taxable property in the City of Hayward, payable in 2019, and hereby, certify its accuracy to the Freeborn County Auditor-Treasurer.


