

Resolution 2019-17

Establishment of City of Hayward Rural Service District

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 272.67 Division of Land in Cities into Rural and Urban Districts allows cities to establish separate taxing districts for the purpose of all municipal property taxes except those levied for the payment of bonds, judgments, and interest thereon, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward established Urban and Rural Service Districts with the adoption of Ordinance 83-1, which was further expanded by motions at the March, 1985 and January, 1995 City Council meetings. The City of Hayward Rural Service District includes those portions of the following parcel IDs which are located within the city boundaries:



NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,


- The levy rate for the 2020 tax year shall remain the same as in Ordinance 83-1; and
