**Authorizing the Placement of the City's Sanitary Sewer Mains' Inspection, Cleaning, and  
Vacuuming on a Four-Year Schedule Beginning on County Road 26  
and the Sewer Lift Station in 2020**

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**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance and cleaning of the City of Hayward's sanitary sewer mains;

**WHEREAS**, the League of Minnesota Cities recommends sanitary sewer mains are cleaned every five years;

**WHEREAS**, during the August 17, 2020 City Council meeting, Council voted to place various segments of the city's sewer mains on a four-year inspection and cleaning rotation schedule in order to make the process more affordable:

Year 1 2020: 2600 ft of sewer cleaning on CR 26 and the lift station

Year 2 2021: 3800 ft of sewer cleaning

Year 3 2022: 3800 ft of sewer cleaning

Year 4 2023: 3800 ft of sewer cleaning

Councilor Ruble motioned to approve that 2600 feet of sewer on CR 26 and cleaning at the lift station shall take place in 2020 and that 3800 feet shall be cleaned in each subsequent year through 2023; Councilor Dolph advanced and **Resolution 2020-13** carried unanimously.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Hayward, that it hereby establishes **Resolution 2020-13**, approving that 2600 feet on Country Road 26 and the lift station shall take place beginning in 2020 and that 3800 feet shall be cleaned in each subsequent year through 2023.
