**UPDATING THE CITY OF HAYWARD EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hayward participated in the hazard mitigation planning process as established under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Act established a framework for the development of a multi-jurisdictional county hazard mitigation plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Of Hayward created a plan of action which is currently titled, *City Of Hayward Emergency Operations Plan*; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hayward Emergency Operations Plan includes the following: Emergency Responsibility Assignments, Command, Planning, Finance, Operations Policies, County, State, Federal Support; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hayward periodically reviews the Emergency Operations Plan to watch for necessary updates due to changing criteria and changes in personnel; and,

**WHEREAS**, on February 13, 2023, during the regular session of the Hayward City Council Meeting, Councilor Dolph introduced Resolution 2023-8, a resolution approving the revision of the City's EOP effective February 13, 2023. Councilor Lerum seconded. The Hayward City Council resolved to update its emergency operations plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Hayward revise its Emergency Operations Plan effective February 13, 2023.
