RESOLUTION 2023-22 CITY OF HAYWARD, FREEBORN COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA

TRANSFER SOME PARK FUNDS TO STREET FUND FOR STREET REPAIRS, RESERVING FUNDS TO PURCHASE A HYDRATION STATION FOR THE CITY PARK

BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Hayward, Minnesota sought a 50/50 matching funds grant for new playground equipment and obtained Council's approval to complete and submit a comprehensive grant application to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on March 13, 2023, with a grant submission deadline of March 31, 2023;

WHEREAS, the City received two tranches of Cares Act Funds for the playpark project; the first tranche went toward construction of a new basketball court and the second tranche, \$13,223.15, was assigned to the Park Fund for new playground equipment;

WHEREAS, \$9,067 from a Trust Fund Account (from Peterson, Kolker, Haedt, & Benda, LTD, Attorney's Office - from Bigelow Construction, '95 Additions) was allocated to the playpark project as also;

WHEREAS, The City did not receive the grant from the DNR, primarily due to environmental concerns related to Monarch Butterflies and a certain type of bat that inhabits the area.

WHEREAS, The City decided to use a portion of the Cares Act Funds to purchase a hydration station for the city park, and transfer the remaining funds, along with the \$9,067 from the Park Fund to the Street Fund for street repairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hayward approves this resolution and authorizes the necessary actions to implement it.
