

# City of Hayward Newsletter

**IMPORTANT!** The Department of Health is requiring all cities to conduct water service line inventories to determine what material all business and residential water lines are made of: plastic, copper, galvanized, or lead. The City of Hayward is responsible for collecting this data.

Residents are asked to do **one** of two things:

- 1) Take a photo of your water service line. The service line in question will be located where the water pipe enters your home structure - either from the floor or wall - before the water shut-off, and before the water meter. Once completed, please email your photo to the city office, [cityofhayward@gofast.am](mailto:cityofhayward@gofast.am) or print a copy and drop it off at the city office. Your photo must include your name, address, and phone number.
- 2) If you prefer, a representative from the City of Hayward can conduct this inspection for you. Please call the city office to make arrangements. Feel free to call us at **507-373-1222** with any questions. Leave a message if necessary. **THANK YOU** for your help with this project!
